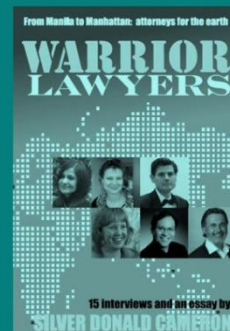

Green Rights: The Human Right to a Healthy World will be presented in a cross-Canada tour in October.

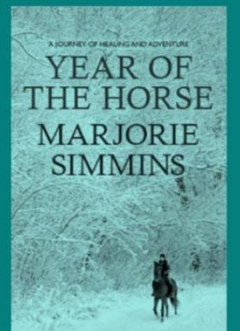
The film's host and executive producer, author Silver Donald Cameron, and his wife, author Marjorie Simmins, will travel across the country to bring the film's important message to Canadians.
